Welcome to the IARRC Robot Racing competition. We are glad to have you here and hope you have a great time.

Friday

Friday has a relaxed schedule and is going to be used for team registrations, basic robot qualifications, and oral presentations. When your team isn't doing these things, you are welcome to setup a workspace in the Student Design Center (SDC) lobby to work on your robot and you can do testing of your robot on outside practice tracks.

The **deadline for qualifying** for the races is Friday 21:00. Additional time is available Saturday morning 07:30-08:30 for late qualifications, however a penalty will apply.

Saturday

Saturday will have all the races and be a busy day. Refer to the updated schedule for the match times, and we need all the teams to be on time to keep on schedule. All races will take place on the outdoor tracks, and other activities (Kickoff, Lunch, Awards Presentation, Dinner) will take place in the SDC lobby. We are monitoring the weather for a chance of thunderstorms. Should they occur, we will quickly move to the SDC lobby and wait for them to pass. We will adjust the schedule as necessary.

Wifi

Wifi is available for participants, but each person/device needs to use a separate login id and password. We will provide these on slips.
